Furthermore, turning his attentions to European conquests, he recognized that his plans there would require an infusion of ready cash. He quite suddenly decided to unload all of the vast territory called Louisiana. Accordingly, Napoleon authorized his ministers to make a counteroffer to the Americans: instead of simply transferring the ownership of New Orleans, France would be willing to part with the entire Louisiana Territory.
